I am writing to you today a letter of recommendation for Adam Olson at his request, but at my great pleasure.

Firstly, about myself: I am Director of Technology and Primary Music Producer for Right On Cue Services. Our company produces music and software for Broadway musical productions. We are the only company in the world to be endorsed by both the composers and licensing companies which sell the rights to musicals for production. As an example...any time a production company decides to perform "Grease" without using a live band, they use tracks which I produced via specialized playback software which I architected.

Right On Cue Services as a company employs a number of full-time and part-time producers, sequencers, developers and administrators across multiple facilities, in addition to a couple dozen independent musicians, engineers and software developers. Outside my career with ROCS, I produce independently for various successful artists...most notably, Lindsey Stirling, as well as have won a Utah Music Award for an album I produced this year.

He was efficient with his use of time while musicians were on the clock, in addition to being punctual to each session.
