- Textbook reading assignments were general-knowledge related, but classroom work and assignments were almost totally software and hardware 'how-to' exercises. Textbook did not support classroom work, as the text was pretty much industry-generic, while the class focused on specific tools and hardware. Step-by-step introduction to the software tools, with in-depth explanation of not only 'how' but 'why' would be helpful. If students were supposed to find and read the software manuals to get an understanding of what they were doing, then that should have been part of the course reading assignments and handouts provided. Throwing students 'into the deep end' and 'sink or swim' results in a lot of drowned students!
- This class for me was, and still is, a huge challenge. I feel that this course needs to involve more accessible computer applications, or even explaining steps as they go along. I got a little of that explanation, but I still don't feel that it's enough for me to really grasp the material. I feel that these midi projects are tedious and without vision, it makes it extremely difficult to complete. I understand that tutors are there to help and support, but even trying to get some of the concepts are very challenging without vision. Also, the textbook for this course is completely inaccessible too. In fact, most of the conservatory course textbooks are now very inaccessible, even in alternative formats. The publishers do not code the books in a way I'm able to read in my computer's voiceover program and It's becoming increasingly difficult to keep up with work and readings now. More consideration needs to be given for people with disabilities throughout this entire university and conservatory. Students have equal opportunity, but when courses are presented in the way I've dealt with, that does not give equal learning opportunities in some areas.
