Tonmeister Seminar (MUPR-311) - Olson, Adam

- Mr. Olson is a fun professor, but I have found he's not entirely thorough. For this class the first three or four classes were the only regular in-class-at-desks format classes before sessions started, but I didn't feel that those few classes adequately prepared me for the sessions. I don't recall Mr. Olson explaining how the sessions were going to work, in that we must find a musician to record, so it took me a while to figure out that that's what he meant. I also don't remember him ever saying that during the sessions we must use all the same mics as the other engineer, and most students I heard from, including me, were docked points by not remembering this. It seems to me that if most students are missing something, the teacher probably didn't adequately emphasize the point, and so it shouldn't be counted against the students. So I would suggest he either emphasize the same microphones more strongly from day 1, or not dock the students points for it. Also I spent most of the semester waiting to have my mic book returned, and by the time it was returned I had already completed both my sessions, so I couldn't even benefit from it for this class. In future semesters please return them within the three weeks as promised.
- The instructions for the proficiency should be a bit more complete. There are things that we were supposed to do in the proficiency that I would have done in a normal session, but were not explicitly listed, so it was unclear exactly what needed done. - I really appreciated all of the feedback we got on the sessions in class. It was helpful to have that feedback rather than just a grade.
